



Curriculum vitae of Professor Anastas Gerdjikov

Anastas Gerdjikov completed his secondary education in 1982 at the National Gymnasium for Ancient Languages and Cultures, Sofia. He studied Classical Philology at Sofia University St. Kliment Ohridski in 1984/1985. In 1985 he pursued his classical studies at Humboldt University in Berlin which he graduated with a Master's Degree in Classical Philology in 1990. In 2000 he was conferred a Ph. D. in Roman Literature at Sofia University, where in 2006 he received Dr. Sc. in Ancient and Medieval Literature.

Since 1990 he is a professor in Ancient and Medieval Literature at Sofia University. He has been Deputy Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Bulgaria (2001-2003). In 2004-2007 Prof. Gerdjikov worked as an expert at the Education and Science Parliamentary Committee to the National Assembly of Bulgaria dealing with preparation of analyses and bills in the field of education and science. In 2008-2009 he occupied the position of Chief executive of the Bulgarian Science Foundation. Prof. Gerdjikov was elected in 2010 as Vice-Rector of Sofia University, responsible for Accreditation and Research. One year later he became a Vice-Rector dealing with PhD education and continuing education until 2015 when Prof. Gerdjikov was elected as Rector of Sofia University and also as Member of the Academic Council. As Rector of Sofia University, he was Member of the Board (2015-2022) and Chairman (2020-2022) of the Bulgarian Rector's Conference.

Prof. Gerdjikov participated in several educational and research projects. He is member of numerous networks and organizations and of the Editorial Board of three research journals. Along with his research publications in the field of Latin language and Roman literature, he is author of a book and a number of articles on Bulgarian Education. He is fluent in English, German, French and Russian.
